006.1. SCHOOL BOARD AGENDA

The Board recognizes the need for the opportunity to discuss agenda items thoroughly prior to the voting meeting each month.

The Board affirms that items to be placed on the monthly agenda for action must first be brought to the full Board during the committee meetings with the normal detailed back-up and with the opportunity for full discussion.

It is also recognized that emergency situations do occur. To allow for these instances, prior to the monthly voting meeting, any such item may be presented to the Board as a part of the agenda with appropriate back-up, to be included at their discretion. These emergency items would be sent home three (3) days prior to the regular Board meeting.

In the event an emergency item cannot be provided to Directors at least three (3) days in advance of the meeting, the Board shall have the authority, upon motion to suspend this policy, to add such item upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote to suspend the rule.

At the regular Board action meeting, prior to voting on any individual agenda item, the Board will first take a vote on the entire agenda to be presented to the Board for consideration during that meeting.

This process will allow emergency items, as well as any other item that an individual Board member or the Superintendent may wish to have considered for the action agenda, to be brought forward. Items will be added by a majority vote.
