126. CLASS SIZE	
1. Authority	The Board has the authority to determine class size with input from the Superintendent.
2. Delegation of Responsibility	The Superintendent will develop guidelines for class size based on the developmental needs of learners, the nature of the content, and the need for special equipment or facilities. Class size recommendations will reflect the language agreed upon in the Collective Bargaining Agreement.
3. Guidelines	<p><u>Electives</u></p> <p>Elective secondary school subjects which carry credit towards graduation shall be offered only when, on the basis of the spring course selection count, eighteen (18) or more students enroll. Such courses may be offered when they are a part of a pilot or special program or are, in the opinion of the administration, deemed essential to instructional activities; any course with less than eighteen (18) students must be approved by the Board.</p>
