EXTRACURRICULAR PARTICIPATION BY NON- ENROLLED/CHARTER/CYBER STUDENTS</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall approve participation in the district’s extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs by a student enrolled in a charter or cyber charter school if all of the following conditions are met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The student is a legal resident of the school district.</li> <li>2. The charter or cyber charter school does not provide the same extracurricular activity or interscholastic athletic program.</li> <li>3. The student fulfills all requirements for participation in the activity or program required for district students.</li> </ol> <p>The Board shall not provide transportation for individual students enrolled in charter or cyber charter schools who participate in the district’s extracurricular activities or interscholastic athletic programs. When the district provides transportation to and from an away competition, game, event or exhibition and requires district students to use district transportation, non-enrolled/charter/cyber charter students shall be required to use the transportation provided by the district.</p> <p>Where the school district contributes to the tuition of the non-enrolled student, the Board may require the charter or cyber charter school to pay the cost of the expenses for its students’ participation in the district’s extracurricular activities or interscholastic athletic programs.</p>

Guidelines</p> <p>Pol. 202</p>	<p>Charter and cyber charter school students shall be given an equal opportunity to compete for positions in district extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs.</p> <p>The following guidelines shall govern participation in the district’s extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs by eligible charter and cyber charter school students who shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Maintain appropriate insurance coverage, consistent with the coverage requirements for district students.</p> <p>3. Comply with Board policies and school rules and regulations regarding extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletics.</p> <p>4. Comply with Board policies and school rules and regulations regarding student discipline.</p> <p>5. Meet the requirements for immunizations, physical examinations and physical fitness.</p> <p>6. Comply with all requirements and directives of the district staff, coaches and administrators involved with the extracurricular activity or interscholastic athletic program.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>A charter or cyber charter school student may only participate in extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs at the school building closest to the charter or cyber charter school or at the school building the student would be assigned to if s/he was enrolled in the school district.</p> <p>The building principal or designee shall receive and review from the charter or cyber charter school written confirmation that a student has met and continues to meet the established participation requirements for the extracurricular activity or interscholastic athletic program.
