223. USE OF BICYCLES AND MOTOR VEHICLES	
1. Purpose	The Board regards the use of motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents/guardians and students.
2. Authority	<p>The Board shall permit the use of motor vehicles and valid licensed vehicles by secondary students in accordance with district rules, provided that such students have followed established procedures and obtained the required permit.</p> <p>The Board prohibits the use of skateboards, mini-bikes, dirt bikes, quads, and any other non-licensed recreational vehicles on school property.</p> <p>The Board shall not be responsible for bicycles, motor vehicles, and other licensed vehicles that are lost, stolen, or damaged on school district property.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The building principal or designee shall develop rules and regulations for operating and parking of motor vehicles and shall disseminate those rules to affected students.</p> <p>The building principal or designee shall establish standards for granting permits, which contain the warning that infraction of rules may result in revocation of the permit.</p>
4. Guidelines	<p>School district security and the School Resource Officer supervise the parking lots, and may deny students the use of the area if the parking rules are disobeyed.</p> <p>Motor vehicles may not be moved from parking lots until the designated time on the parking pass except for an emergency, and with a principal's approval.</p> <p>When more than one (1) student rides in a motor vehicle to school each student must present a pass to the school district security and the School Resource Officer.</p> <p>A motor vehicle used during the school day by students cutting class will void the parking permit for that student. Use of the parking facility is a privilege.</p> <p>All unauthorized motor vehicles shall be ticketed and/or towed.</p>

<p>School Code 510, 1519</p>	<p>Streets adjacent to the perimeter of the school have been posted by the Bethel Park Police Department as a no parking area during the school day. Any motor vehicle parked in the restricted zone will be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense.</p> <p>Parking on school property anywhere but in the parking lots is prohibited.</p> <p>Parking on the campus drive is prohibited by local police regulations.</p> <p>Students may only park in areas designated for student parking.</p> <p>It is expected that students shall park their vehicles in an orderly fashion and operate them in a safe manner at all times.</p> <p>Any licensed or non-licensed vehicle parked on school district property is subject to search.</p>
