



TWO BETHEL PARK SCHOOLS GET 3-A-DAY DAIRY VENDING MACHINES FOR CAFETERIA

Thanks to a successful grant application by Food Service Director **Joe Consolmagno**, the Bethel Park High School and Independence Middle School cafeterias are the recipients of a 3-A-Day Dairy vending machine from the Mid-Atlantic Dairy Association.

The machines, each valued at \$4,500 are located in the cafeterias and are stocked with 1% white and flavored milk pints, string cheese and three varieties of yogurt.

This high tech machine possesses sensitive controls, so that in the event of a power outage, the machine will not dispense any products if the temperature rises to a danger range for an extended period of time.

The machine is designed to encourage students and staff to get their three recommended servings of dairy each day.
