1. Visit events.ahn.org/home
2. Search by keywords "Sports Physicals"
3. Select "Allegheny Health Network High School Sports Physicals – Peters"
4. Review important information listed under "Description"
5. Click "View Website"
6. Select "Register Now" and complete the event registration
7. Once your submission is completed, you will receive a confirmation number and confirmation email.

Before you arrive:

1. Make sure not to arrive earlier than 5 minutes prior to your appointment.
2. Make sure you bring Section 6 (completed) and Section 7 of the PIAA CIPPE with you to this appointment. These documents can be downloaded from the event registration webpage.
3. The cost of the physical is \$20. Only cash or checks are accepted as forms of payment. Checks should be made out to Allegheny Health Network.
