The Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA) and the Community College of Allegheny (CCAC) are partnering to offer a virtual FAFSA Completion Workshop on Monday, November 15th, open to any high school student/family, where one on one assistance will be provided!

At 5 p.m., Amy Sawdey, PHEAA Higher Education Access Partner, will be hosting a FAFSA Overview Presentation, via WebEx, where she will guide students and families through a step-by-step process of filing the FAFSA and state grant application.
