Applications Now Being Accepted for the **Pennsylvania Governor's School for the Sciences at Carnegie Mellon University** The Pennsylvania Governor's School for the Sciences at Carnegie Mellon University is now accepting applications from talented high school juniors for the summer 2022 program. Governor's School is an intensive, five-week summer residential program that emphasizes cooperative learning and hands-on laboratory research for high school juniors pursuing careers in science and mathematics. Accepted applicants will receive a full scholarship to the program. Awarded scholarships will cover the costs of housing, meals, and all instructional materials. Families are responsible for transportation to and from the university, personal items, and spending money. Students must commit to living on campus at Carnegie Mellon University throughout the duration of the program.

When: June 26, 2022 - July 30, 2022

Where: Carnegie Mellon University

Who May Apply: The program is open to high school juniors at time of application who attend a public, nonpublic, or private school or are homeschooled.
