



## MEET THE 2019 BETHEL PARK ATHLETIC HALLOF FAME INDUCTEES

The Bethel Park High Athletic Hall of Fame will induct six new members as its Class of 2019 on Saturday, December 21 during the halftime of the Bethel Park/Gateway Boys Varsity Basketball Game, which will tip off at 1:30 PM in the Bethel Park High School Gymnasium.

This year's inductees include:

- **Charlotte Brackett** (Class of 2008/Swimming) – Charlotte was a four-year letter winner on a team that won four WPIAL and Section Championships (2005-2008), as well two PIAA Silver Medals (2007 and 2008). She is a two-time State Champion and won 10 WPIAL Gold Medals. She swam collegiately for the University of Richmond, where she won 20 Atlantic 10 Conference Gold Medals and guided the Lady Spiders to three Atlantic 10 Conference Titles (2009, 2011 and 2012). She was the 2008 Almanac Athlete of the Year and a 14-time Scholastic All-American.
- **John Schademan** (Class of 2009/Football) – John was a three-year starting wide receiver and defensive back, and was a member of the 2008 WPIAL Championship Team and 2008 PIAA Runner-Up. Offensively, he amassed over 1,687 receiving yards and scored 21 touchdowns. Defensively he had 117 tackles and four interceptions for the Hawks. He was named 2008 First Team All-State. He played collegiately at Colgate and Slippery Rock University, where he helped the Rock win two PSAC West Division Titles. In college he had over 2,300 receiving yards and scored 20 touchdowns.

- **Michael Stewart** (Class of 1971/Football and Baseball) – At Bethel Park, Michael played defensive back, wide receiver and quarterback and scored 11 touchdowns as a senior. In baseball he played right field and helped to lead the Hawks to back-to-back Section Titles (1970, 1971) and to the 1970 WPIAL Title Game. Collegiately, he played football at William & Mary, where he started for three years at the strong safety position and served as Team Captain in 1974. Michael was also on the Bethel Park Coaching Staff for two years, including serving as an Assistant Coach for the 1980 WPIAL Runner-Up Team.
- **Jane Waldie** (Class of 1970/Swimming) – Jane was a four-year letter winner and served as Team Captain in 1970. She was a member of the 1966 and 1967 Section Champions. At WPIALs, she earned four Gold Medals. She swam for Michigan State University, where she was a five-time Big 10 Conference Champion and held over 10 school records. She was a member of the 1973 and 1974 Big 10 Championship Teams. She coached at North Allegheny for more than 30 years and was inducted into the Western Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame in 1993.
- **Mark Wicks** (Class of 1993/Football and Track) – Mark was a three-year football letter winner, who started at tailback for two years and rushed for over 1,300 yards in his senior season. He earned four letters in Track and won two WPIAL Titles in the 100 meters and one WPIAL title in the 400-meter relay. He played wide receiver at Marshall University and was a four-year letter winner on teams that won two Southern Conference Titles, one National Runner-Up title (1995) and one National Division I-AA Championship in 1996.
- **Rebecca Zimmer** (Class of 2009/Swimming) – Rebecca was a four-year letter winner on a team that won three consecutive WPIAL Championships (2006-2008), four consecutive Section Titles (2006-2009) and two consecutive State Silver Medals (2007-2008). She earned 10 WPIAL Gold Medals. In college, she swam for the University of Akron and earned a Silver Medal at the 2012 MAC Championships as a member of the 400 Meter Freestyle Relay Team.

The Hall of Fame will also present the Distinguished Contribution Award to 1960 Bethel Park graduate and Founder of the Athletic Hall of Fame **Ron Evans**, in recognition of his outstanding contributions and remarkable service to the Bethel Park Athletic Hall of Fame.

The Bethel Park Athletic Hall of Fame has been in existence since 1998.
