Apprenticeships are for students in grades 9-12 (during the 2018-2019 school year).

AIU Apprenticeship Programs are held during the school year and during the school day and transportation arrangements must be made by the student/family.

Please note that some programs may change slightly and some programs may be added at a later date. Specific dates for each program will be added as the AIU receives them. Please continue to check the website program descriptions.

Students will need to activate a new online account.

***After students submit their information for a new account it may take a few days to receive the activation email and begin the application.*

To be considered applicants MUST have ALL of the following:

An activated AIU Apprenticeship account

A complete application submitted online

A completed online essay

An online teacher recommendation (teachers must create an account on the AIU website by clicking the account creation button for "I am an educator")

Printed and signed signature page and application fee ***mailed to the AIU***

***Please note that if a student would like to participate in 2 Apprenticeships they must submit 2 application fees.*
