BOARD ACTION SUMMARY

The following is a brief summary of action taken by the Bethel Park Board of School Directors at a Regular Voting Meeting held on May 19, 2020. These are not official meeting minutes. The official minutes for this meeting will be approved at a later date.

Curriculum Committee

Personnel Committee

- The Board ratified the Collective Bargaining Agreement, as presented, between the Bethel Park School District and the Bethel Park School District Transportation Department District Council 84, A.F.S.C.M.E. The contract is effective July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2025.
- The Board approved an Individual Memorandum of Agreement with the Bethel Park Federation of Teachers.
- The Board approved the resignation of **Jill Simpson**, BPHS Family Consumer Science Teacher, effective the end of the 2019-2020 school year for the purpose of retirement.
- The Board rescinded the resignation for retirement request of **Sharon Rosa**, Independence Middle School Social Studies Teacher.
- The Board approved closing the following positions effective June 30, 2020:

- The Board approved a Change of Assignment for **Erin Sebrosky**, from IMS 10 Month Building Secretary to 12 Month Full-Time Facilities and Services Secretary at the Administration Building, retroactively effective May 18, 2020.

Finance Committee

- The Board adopted the 2020-2021 Proposed Final General Fund Budget in the amount of \$92,453,284.
- The Board voted to reduce the facility rental fees as stated in district policy for the Pre K Counts Program for the months of September 2020 through May 2021 at a fee not to exceed \$350.00 a month. This rent would cover the cost for the AIU to rent a room at William Penn Elementary School to operate the program on behalf of the District.
