

REQUIREMENTS FOR PERMANENT CERTIFICATION

Instructional II

- 24 post baccalaureate credits
- 3 years of satisfactory service on the PA Level I Certificate (all areas will convert simultaneously)
- Completion of a Pennsylvania Department of Education Approved Induction program; and if Instructional I was issued in accordance with September 1999 regulations (effective date of September 1, 2001 or thereafter), satisfactory results on Level II assessment

Educational Specialist II

- 24 post baccalaureate credits
- 3 years of satisfactory service in each conversation area requested
- If Instructional I was issued in accordance with September 1999 regulations (effective date of September 1, 2001), completion of a Pennsylvania Department of Education Approved Induction Program; and If Educational Specialist I was issued in accordance with September 1999 regulations (effective date of September 1, 2001 or thereafter), satisfactory results on Level II assessment

Administrative II and Supervisory II

- If issued in accordance with June 1987 regulations, 3 years of satisfactory service on the Pennsylvania Administrative I or Supervisory I certificate in each area to be converted

Vocational Instructional II

- 60 credit hours in an approved program in the appropriate field of vocational education
- 3 years of satisfactory service on the Pennsylvania Vocational Level I certificate attested to by the chief school administrator of the Pennsylvania approved public, nonpublic or vocational-technical school entity in which the vocational teaching was completed
- Completion of a Pennsylvania Department of Education Approved Induction program
- Passing scores on the appropriate Praxis Series exam(s) for Pennsylvania; and Recommendation from an approved Pennsylvania University (Temple University, Pennsylvania State University, or Indiana University of Pennsylvania).
