Re: Positive COVID-19 cases reported at Memorial, Franklin, NAMS and BPHS

Over the weekend, students at Memorial Elementary (2), Franklin Elementary (1) and Bethel Park High School (3) have each tested positive for COVID-19. Also, staff members at Neil Armstrong Middle School (1) and Bethel Park High School (1) have each tested positive for coronavirus. They were each last in school last week or the week before.

Bethel Park School District's health and safety protocols mandate that the individuals will remain isolated at home until their symptoms have abated and they have been cleared by a medical professional as being no longer contagious.
