Re: Positive COVID-19 cases reported at Washington, Memorial and BPHS

Last night and today, students at George Washington Elementary (1), Memorial Elementary (1) and Bethel Park High School (3) have each tested positive for COVID-19. A staff member at Bethel Park High School also tested positive for COVID-19. The Washington Elementary student was last in school, Sept. 7. The Memorial Elementary student was last in school, Sept. 8. The most recent any of the high school students were last in school was Sept. 3. The staff member was last in school Sept. 9.

Bethel Park School District's health and safety protocols mandate that the individuals will remain isolated at home until their symptoms have abated and they have been cleared by a medical professional as being no longer contagious.

If your child tests positive for COVID-19, please notify your child's school nurse as soon as possible. Also, if your child is demonstrating any symptoms commonly associated with COVID-19 (fever, headache, muscle or body aches, congestion, loss of taste or smell, etc.), please play it safe and keep them home from school.
