Re: Positive COVID-19 cases reported at NAMS, IMS and BPHS

Earlier today, it was reported that three Bethel Park students have tested positive for COVID-19. The impacted schools include Neil Armstrong Middle School (1), Independence Middle School (1) and Bethel Park High School (1).

The most recent days in school for those cases were:

- Neil Armstrong Middle School: Nov. 5
- Independence Middle School: Nov. 5
- Bethel Park High School: Nov. 9

Bethel Park School District's health and safety protocols mandate that the individuals will remain isolated at home until their symptoms have abated and the students have been cleared by a medical professional as being no longer contagious.

If your child tests positive for COVID-19, please notify your child's school nurse as soon as possible. Also, if your child is demonstrating any symptoms commonly associated with COVID-19 (fever, headache, muscle or body aches, congestion, loss of taste or smell, etc.), please play it safe and keep them home from school.

Finally, **anyone who visits any Bethel Park school during the school day will be asked to answer some basic screening questions** as we try our best to limit COVID-19 transmission amongst our school community.
