Dear Bethel Park Families,

***Re: Positive COVID-19 cases reported at Franklin, Memorial, Washington and BPHS***

Today, students and staff at Memorial Elementary School (1), George Washington Elementary School (1) and Bethel Park High School (3) have reported testing positive for COVID-19.

**The most recent days in school for those cases were:**

- Memorial Elementary School: Dec. 6
- George Washington Elementary School: Dec. 9
- Bethel Park High School: Dec. 8

Bethel Park School District's health and safety protocols mandate that those individuals will remain isolated at home until their symptoms have abated and they have been cleared by a medical professional as being no longer contagious.

If your child tests positive for COVID-19, please notify your child's school nurse as soon as possible. Also, if your child is demonstrating any symptoms commonly associated with COVID-19 (fever, headache, muscle or body aches, congestion, loss of taste or smell, etc.), please play it safe and keep them home from school.

Finally, **anyone who visits any Bethel Park school during the school day will be asked to answer some basic screening questions** as we try our best to limit COVID-19 transmission amongst our school community.
