***Re: Bethel Park to partner with UPMC on Vaccination Clinic***

Bethel Park School District, in collaboration with UPMC, will be holding a second dose COVID-19 vaccination clinic for students age 16 and over.

The first dose of the Pfizer vaccine was administered in May and the second dose of the vaccine will be administered at Bethel Park High School's south gymnasium tomorrow, June 3, **from 9 to 11 a.m.**

As was the case for the first dose, this email also [includes a permission form](#) that must be printed, completed and returned to the high school personnel on hand at the vaccination clinic. All students must have their parents or guardians' expressed consent to be inoculated. There will be no proof of insurance requested at the event and no copay is involved.

*Please note:*

- *Students must be age 16 or older by no later than May 13, 2021 to qualify.*
- *This clinic is voluntary without any recommendation, direction or coercion from anyone at BPSD.*
- *This clinic will be facilitated by UPMC and its employees.*
- *BPSD is not liable for any injury, loss or damage that may occur following vaccination.*
- *Those scheduled for an appointment should NOT report if they or someone in their household is exhibiting any sign or symptom consistent with COVID-19, or if they were identified as a close contact of someone diagnosed with the virus.*
- *Students are responsible for any missed coursework they incur to receive their COVID-19 vaccination. Please communicate with your teacher(s) beforehand to avoid any unnecessary confusion.*
