Basic Information

Months & Days of Operation

- October, November, and December – Fall Session
- March, April, and May – Spring Session
- Classes will be held Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday
- Check the current calendar for days school is not in session

Regular Time Schedule

- A.M. Session is for older children (four/five year old group) 8:35 – 11:15 A.M.
- P.M. Session is for younger children (three/four year old group) 11:30 – 1:30 P.M.
- PLEASE BE **ON TIME** FOR DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP!!
- 2-Hour Delay for Bethel Park School District – schedule posted online

Fee Requirements

- Fall session of attendance is \$100.00 – Spring session of attendance is \$100.00
- Checks must be payable to “Bethel Park Activity Fund”
- Fee is due on the first day of Fall and Spring session

Nutrition and Snack Information

- Each parent signs up for two or more days which your child will bring snack (special helper day – get to hold the flag and wear the weather vest)
- We will supply 100% fruit juice to drink each day
- Recommended snacks are: cheese-its, graham crackers, animal cookies, goldfish, pretzels, cheese cubes, fruit wedges, popcorn, raisins, yogurt, fruit snacks, string cheese, vegetables and dip (Bethel Park has a wellness policy listed on our website)
- Tell us if you would like to celebrate your child’s birthday – we will make it special for them!

Illness Policy

- If your child is not feeling well, or has a fever, please keep your child at home
- Make us aware of a person available during center hours, your child may be sent home early

Requirements of Parents and Guardians

- Complete and sign all downloadable forms from this site – health history form, enrollment information form, and activity permission form dated for the months of preschool term
- Sign-up for two snack days on our calendar
- Turn in registration fee of \$100.00
- Provide a change of clothes (pants, t-shirt, underwear, socks) in a labeled bag to keep for the duration of the session in your child’s locker – in case of an “accident”
- Look for special events and days off on the current calendar – posted online
